• Erika's DIY tip: fill domes with large tree ornaments, miniature topiary trees or a collection of pinecones to make them pop.

Erika's keywords for this clean, modern look were "simple yet elegant." She mixed luxurious materials and a variety of sheens and textures to create warmth and depth – always a challenge when working with one colour. Using a large opal mirror as the backdrop, Erika then incorporated uniquely shaped glass and silver accents to complete this luxurious all white look.
