Three programs are run from the school: a Kindergarten to Grade 6 Day School that services the Island & Harbourfront community, a residential Outdoor Ed. program for up to 60 students in Grades 5 and 6, and a non-profit daycare: Gibraltar Day Nursery. Day school students are transported to the school by ferry and school bus. We have 11 classes which includes the Full-day Kindergarten program which are supported by Music, Core French, Physical And Health Education, Media Literacy, Dance & Drama and Special Education. The outdoor ed. program offers a three day two over-night excursion.

 **Roundhouse Park**  about a 5 minute walk - 0.4 KM away

Roundhouse Park was created in 1997 on top of the southern expansion of the Metro Toronto Convention Centre. The park features the original, fully restored and operational 120-foot long locomotive turntable and a carefully chosen collection of full-sized railway equipment. It is home to the Toronto Railway Historical Association live steam miniature railway and other outdoor exhibits illustrating Toronto's railway heritage. Exhibits include the original 60,000 gallon water tower, the 650 ton concrete locomotive coaling tower and a collection of historic buildings, including the Don Station and Cabin D.

This small parkette across the street from the Toronto Convention Centre is a good spot to eat lunch or have a quiet moment. It features the 'Worker's Monument', a millennial project by the Workplace Safety Insurance Board to honour lives lost due to workplace injury or illness, and a metal structure that represents the tent in which the newly appointed Lieutenant-Governor John Graves Simcoe and his family spent their first winter in York (Toronto) in 1793. Also located in this park is "mountain", an aluminium sculpture by internationally renowned British artist Anish Kapoor.

### St Michael's Hospital

As downtown Toronto's adult trauma centre, the hospital is a hub for neurosurgery, complex cardiac and cardiovascular care, diabetes and osteoporosis care, minimally invasive surgery and care of the homeless and disadvantaged. St. Michael's is also one of the province's major sites of care for critically ill patients. Fully affiliated with the University of Toronto, St. Michael's provides outstanding medical education to health-care professionals in 29 academic disciplines.

SchoolQ Scores are based on publicly available provincial standardized testing results, aggregated at the school level, standardized, weighted, and rescaled to generate a score out of 10.

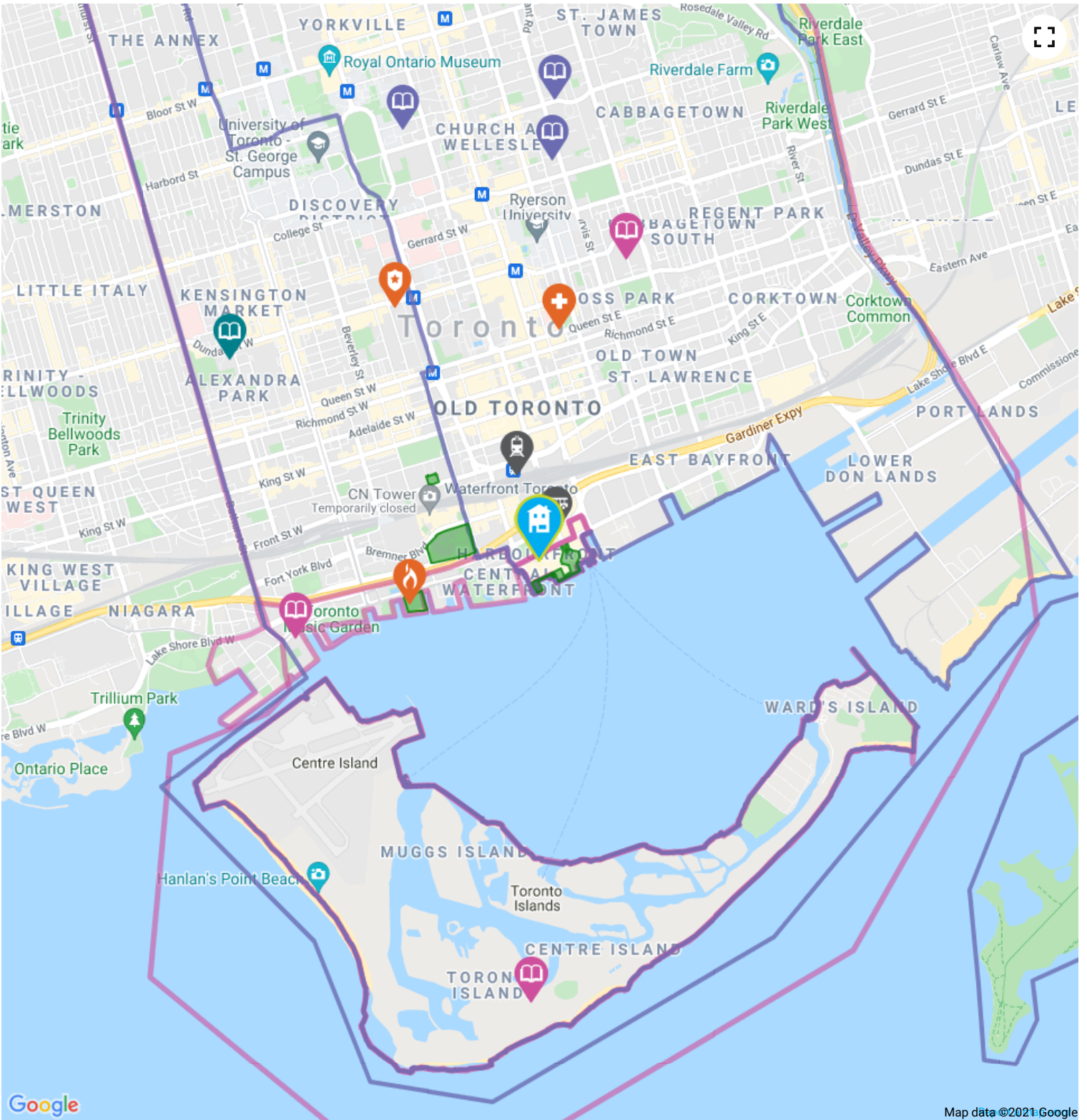
The Parks & Recreation Score is based on two factors - the number of parks and recreation centres near this address and the number of facilities available at those locations.











The Transit Score is based on proximity to public transit access points, both Street-Level and Rail, including buses, streetcars, subways, and trains.

The Safety Score is based on proximity to emergency service agencies, specifically Fire Stations, Police Stations, and Hospitals.

The Convenience Score is based on proximity to Gas Stations, Pharmacies, and Grocery Stores.
